Applications for our 2025 program are now open, and students are encouraged to apply. Reasons to join the Instrumental Music program

- Learn to play an instrument!
- Make new friends!
- Encourages self-discipline!
- Opportunities to travel and perform!
- Helps to improve the brain. There have been many studies carried out that show that music is one of the few disciplines that stimulates both left and right sides of the brain and builds new brain pathways.

Instruments

The different instruments on offer in the Instrumental Music program at Blackwater North State School are flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, french horn, trombone, euphonium, baritone and percussion.

Student Selection

Students will be required to attend suitability testing and selected according to the following criteria.

- Keenness to learn
- Musical aptitude
- Physical characteristics pertinent to a particular instrument
- Commitment of students and parents to daily practice and to regular attendance at lessons and rehears-
- Evaluation by the classroom teacher on areas such as academic results, ability to work independently, work habits, discipline, co-operation with the teacher and other students, and their school attendance record.

Expenses

Whilst the lessons themselves are free, there are still some associated costs. These include;

- \$15 yearly program fee
- \$50 instrument hire fee (if hiring)
- Personal resources such as a tuition folder, music stand and instrument-specific equipment

Lessons

Each week students attend a 30-minute lesson during school time. These lessons are taken on a small group basis with each group having between 3 and 6 pupils. Students are only eligible to have lessons in the Instrumental Music program on one instrument. A rotating timetable is in place to minimise the disruption to learning in the classroom.

Band

Once your child has suitable ability on their instrument, they will be invited to participate in the concert band. It is a requirement of the program that all students participate within an ensemble setting. Rehearsals take place either before or after school hours, which students must be available for. Students must also take part in performances and excursions held throughout the year and there may be additional costs for these. You must ensure that your child arrives on time and with all necessary equipment to all rehearsals and performances.

Commitment

Every student offered a position in the Instrumental Music program must complete a commitment form before commencing involvement in the program. This entails students agreeing to the following:

- Commitment to a minimum of one year's tuition and ensemble rehearsals.
- Turn up on time to every lesson, rehearsal, and concert with all necessary equipment.
- Show respect to teachers and others in the class
- Do regular practice
- Take care of their instrument
- Always keep trying

Parents are also asked to sign a commitment form, endorsing your child's participation in the program. This entails parents agreeing to the following.

- Ensure your child is equipped with all necessary equipment
- Ensure your child has a regular practice routine
- Ensure your child attends and arrives on time to all rehearsals, lessons, and concerts.
- Ensure your child will be able to attend excursions and camps
- Ensure an instrument will be bought for your child after one year's tuition
- Ensure that you always encourage your child
- Ensure that school instruments and equipment are cared for at home.
